## LITURGY OF THE WORD

### FIRST READING:

Genesis 18:20–32

The Lord said, 'How great an outcry there is against Sodom and Gomorrah! How grievous is their sin! I propose to go down and see whether or not they have done all that is alleged in the outcry against them that has come up to me. I am determined to know.' The men left there and went to Sodom while Abraham remained standing before the Lord. Approaching him he said, 'Are you really going to destroy the just man with the sinner? Perhaps there are fifty just men in the town. Will you really overwhelm them, will you not spare the place for the fifty just men in it? Do not think of doing such a thing: to kill the just man with the sinner, treating just and sinner alike! Do not think of it! Will the judge of the whole earth not administer justice?' The Lord replied, 'If at Sodom I find fifty just men in the town, I will spare the whole place because of them.' Abraham replied, 'I am bold indeed to speak like this to my Lord, I who am dust and ashes. But perhaps the fifty just men lack five: will you destroy the whole city for five?' 'No,' he replied, 'I will not destroy it if I find forty-five just men there.' Again, Abraham said to him, 'Perhaps there will be only forty there.' 'I will not do it' he replied, 'for the sake of the forty.' Abraham said, 'I trust my Lord will not be angry, but give me leave to speak perhaps there will only be thirty there.' 'I will not do it' he replied, 'if I find thirty there.' He said, 'I am bold indeed to speak like this, but perhaps there will only be twenty there.' 'I will not destroy it' he replied, 'for the sake of the twenty.' He said, 'I trust my Lord will not be angry if I speak once more: perhaps there will only be ten.' 'I will not destroy it' he replied, 'for the sake of the ten.'

## **A Meditation on the Pattern of Divine Sonship**

Some prayers we compose — others compose us. The Lord's Prayer belongs to the latter: not a rote recital, but the very charter of life with God. It teaches, reforms, and draws us into divine intimacy.

### **Our Father**

With these words, Christ grants us access to the Father — not a distant deity but a loving Abba. The One who alone could say "My Father" now teaches us to say, "Our Father." We are not mere subjects, but beloved children, heirs with Christ, welcomed into divine adoption. This is not the cold paternalism of duty, but the warm confidence of a child calling out, "Abba, Father." The infinite has drawn near, not in abstraction but in affection. Here, Christianity stands apart: it is not we who grope toward the divine, but God who has stooped to adopt us, making us heirs with Christ and images of His Son.

### **Hallowed Be Thy Name**

The modern mind is awash with values — wealth, status, health, pleasure — and each name clamours for our devotion. We are summoned to hallow one Name alone. This is no polite reverence but the reordering of life around the holiness of God — In hallowing His name, we dethrone the lesser idols and confess that God is not merely first among equals but the very wellspring of all goodness.

### **Thy Kingdom Come, Thy Will Be Done**

The Kingdom is neither a distant dream nor a private faith. It arrived in Christ and advances wherever hearts yield to Him. In prayer and Eucharist, the Kingdom breaks in now — even as we await its final consummation in Christ's return.

### **Give Us This Day Our Daily Bread**

This petition reaches both body and soul. Christ, our true Bread, gives Himself daily in the Eucharist, nourishing us into His likeness — sustaining us as we journey to His Kingdom.

### **Forgive Us Our Trespases, As We Forgive**

Forgiveness is the heart of Christian living. We cannot ask what we refuse to give. As Christ forgave us on the cross, so we are called to forgive — laying down our grudges in the shadow of His mercy.

### **Lead Us Not into Temptation But Deliver Us**

We pray not for immunity from trial, but for God's rescue amid temptation. By His grace, we resist evil, sharing in Christ's victory over darkness. The Lord's Prayer is more than words — it is the pattern of sonship, the cry of dependence, and the song of hope. It is larger within than it seems without — ever drawing us into the Father's heart, where we are named His children.

**Alléluia !****GOSPEL:****Luke 11:1-13**

Once Jesus was in a certain place praying, and when he had finished, one of his disciples said, 'Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples.' He said to them, 'Say this when you pray: "Father, may your name be held holy, your kingdom come. give us each day our daily bread, and forgive us our sins, for we ourselves forgive each one who is in debt to us. And do not put us to the test." He also said to them, 'Suppose one of you has a friend and goes to him in the middle of the night to say, "My friend, lend me three loaves because a friend of mine on his travels has just arrived at my house and I have nothing to offer him"; and the man answers from inside the house, "Do not bother me. The door is bolted now, and my children and I are in bed; I cannot get up to give it to you." I tell you, if the man does not get up and give it to him for friendship's sake, persistence will be enough to make him get up and give his friend all he wants. 'So I say to you: Ask, and it will be given to you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened to you. For the one who asks always receives; the one who searches always finds; the one who knocks will always have the door opened to him. what father among you would hand his son a stone when he asked for bread? Or hand him a snake instead of a fish? Or hand him a scorpion if he asked for an egg? If you then, who are evil, know how to give your children what is good, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!'
